

## **Banner Policy**

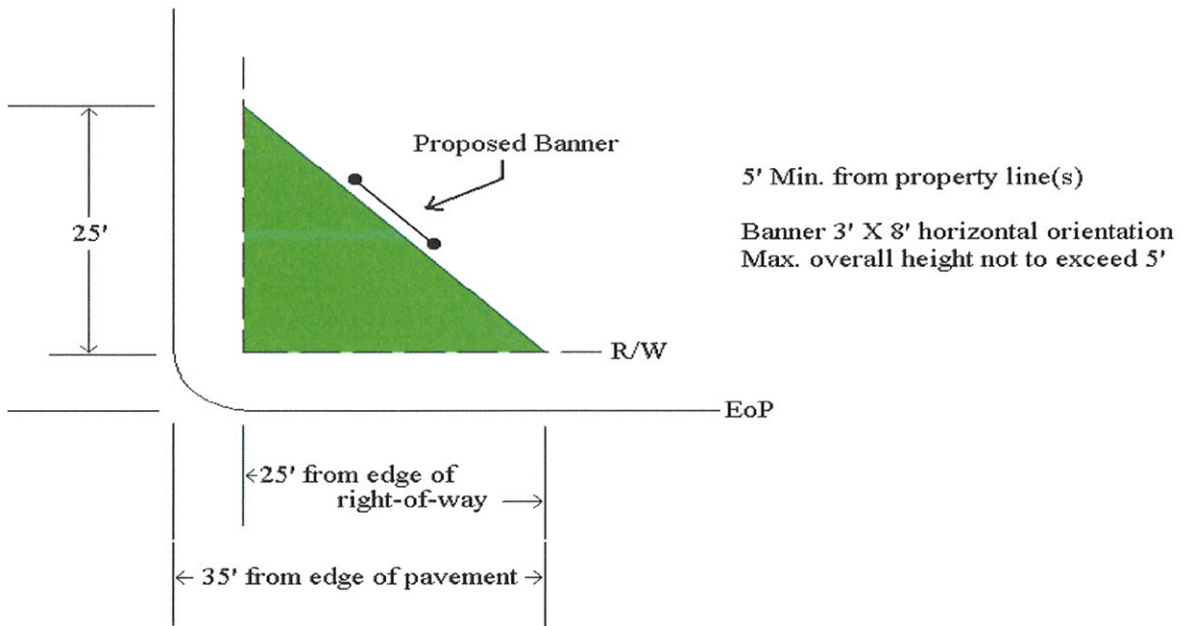
Banner Requests are approved on a first come first served basis dependent on available space. Banners will only be permitted that are beneficial to the City of Fishers or are directly related to the residents of Fishers. The City will accept a banners request for: (1) events originating internally from City of Fishers Departments; (2) events sponsored by the City of Fishers; and (3) events for non-profit organizations, individuals, associations, etc. For-Profit entities are generally prohibited from displaying banners in City right-of-ways. However, for-profit entities may request banners if they meet at least one of the following criterion: (1) holding an event that is completely free and open to the public; or (2) providing 100% of any and all revenues from an event to a non-profit 501(c)(3) designated organization. Approvals are contingent upon relevance to the City of Fishers Community, as determined through the review process.

## **Banner Requirements**

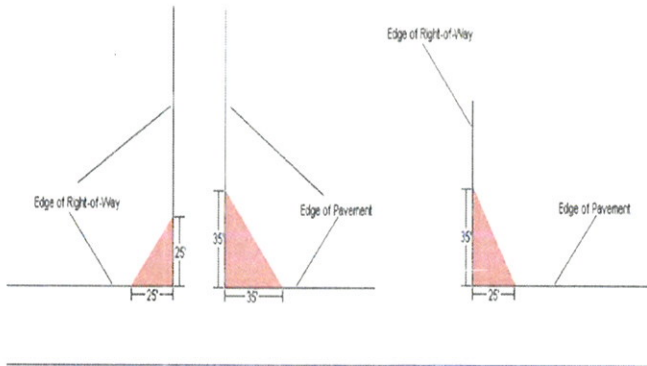
Banners must not exceed three (3) feet by eight (8) feet and must contain grommets. Total height from ground to top may not exceed five (5) feet. A scale drawing/rendering of the proposed banner(s) or sign(s) must be attached. You are responsible for calling 811 or 1-800-382-5544 and following the 'Call Before You Dig' procedures for locates at least 48 hours (excluding weekends and major holidays) before installation of any posts or banner structures. A ticket number will be provided and should be kept as verification of your call and compliance with the law ([www.iupps.org](http://www.iupps.org)).

One applicant may not use more than three (3) of the eight (8) locations available for banners for one (1) event. Banners may only be placed on one corner of an intersection, leaving the other three (3) corners free at all times (corners specified in approved intersection listing below). Locations are limited to one (1) or two (2) total banners. Banners are approved on a first come first served basis dependent upon available space.

- SE Corner of 116th St. & Brooks School Rd.
- Holland Park Entrance
- SW corner of 126th St. & Cumberland Rd.
- In front of Fire Station 3 (adjacent to airport)
- SE corner of 126th St. & Olio Rd.
- South side of airport facing 96th St. (in front of Sams Club & Menards)
- NE corner of Allisonville Rd. & 116th St. (in front of Shell)
- SW corner of 106th St. & Cumberland Rd.



### CORNER VISION CLEARANCE



No sign shall be placed within the Corner Vision Clearance triangle

A minimum setback of five feet (5') shall be maintained from any Right-Of-Way or Property Line
