PAY IN ADVANCE: If you do not wish to appear in court, and you are not charged with an offense which requires you to appear in court, you may admit your charges before your court date. If you are charged with more than one violation, and any of those violations requires you to appear in Court, you must appear in Court to answer all of the violations issued. Because time is required for the Police Department and Court staff to process your ticket, **you must wait seven days from the date you receive your citation to pay your ticket.**

PERSONS UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE MUST APPEAR IN COURT WITH A PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN BEFORE PAYMENT IS ACCEPTED. (Except for seatbelt violations, which may be paid in advance).

PAYMENT BY MAIL: To admit to your charges by mail, sign the bottom of your copy of the ticket and submit to the Court at the address above. Payment needs to be received **BEFORE** your Court date which is located at the bottom of your ticket. If you wish the Court to mail you a receipt, you must enclose a stamp self-addressed envelope with your payment. Payment by mail is accepted by **CASHIER'S CHECK OR MONEY ORDER ONLY.**

PAYMENT IN PERSON: If you wish to pay in person, you may do so before your Court date at the Fishers Train Station, 11601 Municipal Dr. Fishers IN 46038. Cash and money orders are accepted

PAYMENT BY CREDIT CARD: You may pay online at <https://publicaccess.courts.in.gov/pay>. The Fishers Train Station has computers available for credit card payments. Credit cards are not accepted at the window. **THERE IS A FEE TO PAY WITH CREDIT CARDS.**

This amount must be paid whether you appear in Court or not; the amount is set by the State Legislature and cannot be waived or suspended. The schedule below shows the amount payable if you are not required to attend court. Fines may vary for those who appear in court and for those who miss any scheduled court date. Fines may vary depending on facts presented in court, during a trial or at any hearing.
