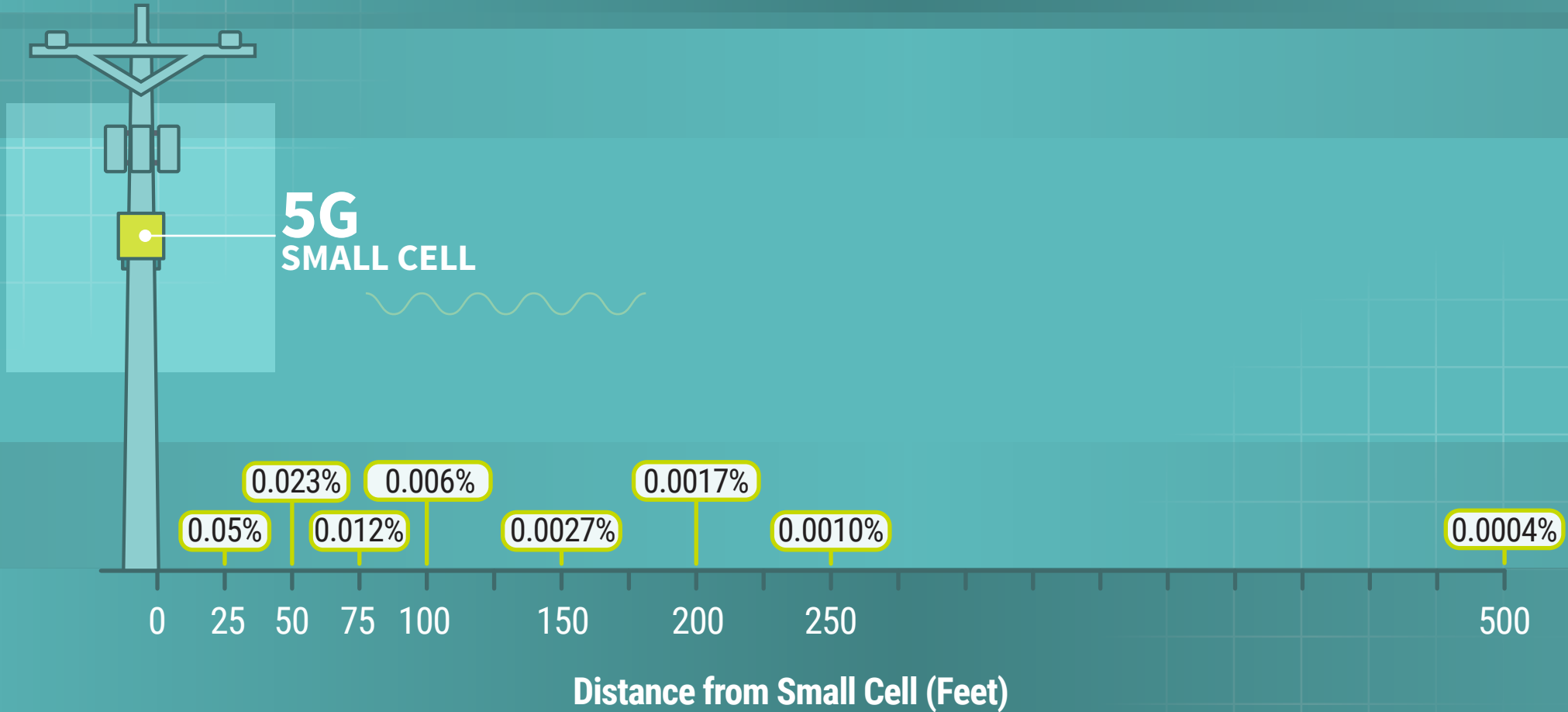


Typical Exposure from a 5G Small Cell

(% of FCC Limit)



This chart shows typical exposures as a percent of the FCC limit for a 5G small cell. The limit is generally taken to be a worst case (whole body) exposure value from a source whereas a typical exposure is a more realistic exposure one might expect to receive from a given source. The maximum exposure would usually exist only at a specified distance from the source whereas the typical exposure might occur at a wide range of locations and represent a more realistic exposure from a given source.
