

SOUTHEASTERN PKWY. & CYNTHEANNE RD. ROUNDBABOUT

Drive Fishers is the City of Fishers' initiative to increase travel efficiency, improve connectivity, and maintain the sanitary sewer and water infrastructure via innovative projects and a proactive approach to construction and maintenance.

Since 2012, Drive Fishers has completed traffic calming projects, sanitary and storm sewer projects, 200 resurfaced lane miles, 112 miles of trails and sidewalks, and received more than \$79 million in grants, improving the infrastructure in Fishers while leveraging federal dollars to save money for the Fishers' taxpayers.

Infrastructure improvement projects contribute to long-term vitality of our community and increased economic development opportunities. PROJECT SCOPE

The City of Fishers is building a roundabout with multi-use paths at the intersection of Southeastern Parkway and Cyntheanne Road.

The proposed project is to provide connectivity for pedestrians and bicyclists into and through the area by providing multi-use paths along either side of both Cyntheanne Road and Southeastern Parkway.

The need for the project is due to the inefficiency of the existing intersection at Cyntheanne Road and Southeastern Parkway in moving traffic through the area. Traffic conditions at this location are expected to increase over time due to anticipated residential and commercial development.

The roundabout will be constructed using phased construction while maintaining access to all businesses and residences.
