

106TH STREET & HOOSIER ROAD ROUNDABOUT

Drive Fishers is the City of Fishers' initiative to increase travel efficiency, improve connectivity, and maintain the sanitary sewer and water infrastructure via innovative projects and a proactive approach to construction and maintenance.

Since 2012, Drive Fishers has completed traffic calming projects, sanitary and storm sewer projects, 200 resurfaced lane miles, 112 miles of trails and sidewalks, and received more than \$79 million in grants, improving the infrastructure in Fishers while leveraging federal dollars to save money for the Fishers' taxpayers.

Infrastructure improvement projects contribute to long-term vitality of our community and increased economic development opportunities. PROJECT SCOPE

The City of Fishers is currently in the design phase of constructing a single lane roundabout at 106th Street and Hoosier Road to replace the four-legged intersection. The roundabout will have a low profile rolled curb and gutter and will provide pedestrian crossings on all four approaches.

The need for the project is to improve safety and reduce delay at the intersection of 106th Street and Hoosier Road.

The roundabout will be constructed under full closure of 106th Street, Hoosier Road and Windemere Blvd. to through traffic and only local residents will have access. Detour routes will be marked.
